Folkmoot Minutes November 24, 2019

Old Business

Gimli 2020

- The Coronation request is in and we are waiting to hear back
- We are looking for bids for Gimli 2020

Cold Day in L (12th Night 2020)

- The event will be happening February 1, 2020 at 448 Burnell St
- Please inform the feast steward, Lady Matrena (Tanya), if there are food allergies
- Royalty, including from Avacal, are interested in coming and possibly some of the populace of Avacal as well
- It is recommended that you sign up for feast sooner than later to ensure a spot
- There will be a nalbinding 2.0 class by Lady Asta (Nat)
- Fees: \$20 feast, site \$15/\$10 members

Just For The L Of It (50th Anniversary Event)

- There will be a tour of the site for the 50th Anniversary event on November 30th at 2:30pm. We will be looking at layout of the grounds as well as the interior layout

Hall Dates

- There is still only 1 meeting date in December but we are looking into it; there is a new manager for the hall

New Business

SUN Bid

- There was a request for us to put in a SUN bid for November 2020
- The bid opens in 2 months
- We have put in a request to a recommended church to use it as the site for SUN. The site can be viewed this Thursday. There is also a fibre arts presentation there at 6:45 pm, if you want to attend please contact Mistress Ainesleah (Jocelyn)
- We can have food classes in the kitchen in the afternoon. We may need to have brewing and vintning classes at someones house, but we are looking into the site options
- We will need to supply site, lunch (but not feast), and a projector to hook up to a laptop – the rest is arranged by the SUN representative
- There was a discussion regarding post revel options. Suggestions included a hotel or possibly someones house
- This is a 1 day event normally - 1 ½ might be an option – the second day would need to be approximately 10am-2pm so people can travel
- We need a good price from the church or another way to ensure we break even; we may need a different site if the church is too costly
- There was a motion to bid on SUN and it was seconded, voted, and passed
- Baron David said he can run the event as he will have fewer Baronial duties to attend to

Brown Bag Collegium

- A brown bag collegium was suggested as we haven't done one in a while – a local day of classes at a site in town where people research topics they are interested in and then share what they found
- It would be a garbed event where you bring your own lunch but site, coffee, and tea would be provided. The Oriels site was suggested

Financial

- Changes to the SCA financial policy have made raffles and online auctions prohibited activities
- A silent auction (bidding) would be allowed
- Baron David will look into the specifics regarding this situation as well as the possibility of an individual running a raffle (rather than the Barony) and then the individual making a donation to the Barony
- Discussion as to whether there are any other options for fundraising than raffles. If anyone has suggestions please let us know
- We may want to ask a contact how the Kingdom of Ealdormere is handling it
- There was a suggestion to have tickets for \$2 to the private beach party at Gimli and then donate the funds to Barony
- It was asked what sort of fundraising is allowed? No answer yet
- We need to look into this further to clarify what we can and can't do

Meetings

- Reminder that once a month we have an extra hour at the meeting site and can do crafting – people are encouraged to bring illumination or other crafting out as well as fighting gear
- Do we want to move folkmoot back to the third Sunday of the month starting January? Motion to keep it on the last Sunday of the month (the same day as dance) – seconded, voted, and passed

-Raffles – If the person running the raffle is a private individual they can run it and proceeds can then be donated

It was seconded, voted, and passed.
