## Folkmoot Minutes February 23, 2020

### Old Business

#### **Cold Day in L (12th Night 2020)**

- We need to get the event on other Kingdom websites, promote via mundane contacts as well possibly like the Mayor or Premier
- We are looking into whether the Non-Such Gallery can be opened for a photo event on the Sunday morning after the event
- Requested space by Chantal Parron to set up a photo booth area

## Old Business Continued

### **Gimli 2020 and 2021**

- There was a second announcement for a bid with the plan for a weekend at Hampton Court - a gathering of the great families of the Tudor age. Take part in tournament fighting, jousting, hunting, a masked ball (with mask making on site), and a bardic competition. No changes to fees, camping fees still need to be confirmed with site
- Counter bids are requested
- Lady Lorette (Brandi) has volunteered to run Gimli 2021 if the stronghold is established

### **Financial**

- The Financial Policy review is due in ASAP to Lady Amaryllis (Sara); review of the Baronial laws will likely be require, and the deadline for this revision commentary is Feb 29<sup>th</sup>
- Update on the bid on Halic High School closure bows (9 bows up for bid) - closure on bids is Thursday and an upper limit of \$250 USD (~\$375 CAD 1.45 exchange to account for handling fee) was approved previously, the final payment is \$107 USD

### **Swap Meet**

- March 1, 2020 will be our next swap meet day so please bring out your items for exchange

### **SUN Bid**

- The SUN bid has been submitted
- The tentative site rental fee is \$944.19
- The site is fully handicap accessible

## New Business

### **Announcement**

The following law change is being considered, please send any comments to [comments@northshield.org](mailto:comments@northshield.org) by March 15, 2020.

#### V-3230 -- Canadian Signatory

The Canadian Signatory officer is a Lesser Officer to the Chancellor of the Exchequer and is responsible for being the designated kingdom signatory for all Canadian accounts.

To be changed to

#### V-3230 -- Alternate Signatory

The Alternate Signatory officers are Lesser Officers to the Chancellor of the Exchequer and are responsible for being an additional signatory on the kingdom accounts or the designated kingdom signatory for local accounts if the Chancellor of the Exchequer cannot be because of residency. At least one of the officers must be resident of the US and one must be a resident of Canada.

There are two reasons for this change: first by calling it the Canadian Signatory there is the assumption that the Kingdom exchequer must be from US and that is not the case. Second, when the law changes were made to make all officers that handled money lesser officers rather than deputies, so they had to be vetted by Stallari, the extra signatories on the kingdom account were overlooked. This covers both those changes.

## New Business Continued

### **Stronghold of Westwatch**

- Shilo/Western Manitoba are currently working (with the TANG) to set up a Stronghold; a Stronghold is similar to a Canton but situated on a Military base
- There was a request to petition the Barony to support the creation of a Stronghold in the Shilo-Brandon area with about a dozen members. This would require financial policy and Baronial law updates to the inclusion of a Stronghold. We need to overcome the Canadian Military/American military differences related to Military ID. The Society Seneschal is on board with the Canadian rules being different. The estimated timeline is a year. The Barony members in attendance were in support.

### **Regional Fight Practice**

- It was recommended that regional practices shouldn't be held the same weekend as Folkmoot as it seems to reduce meeting attendance
- It was suggested we try for another Saturday in March and April
- Questions raised for consideration: Do we want to do a potluck? Should we move folkmoot?

### **50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tokens**

- Site tokens for the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event were planned to also be given to guests at our events throughout the remainder year. As their cost was more than planned in the event budget, their Excellencies had graciously offered to pay for them out of pocket. The price was higher than expected and they made a request for the difference to be covered by the Barony.
- There was a motion for the Barony to cover 100% of the cost (500 tokens for \$730 USD) and it was seconded, voted, and passed

## Old Business

### **Gimli 2020 or 2021 (Next Gimli)**

- There was a final announcement for a bid with the planned theme a weekend at Hampton Court – it was voted on and passed
- It will be happening at the Ukrainian Camp site as usual
- We want to get it on the calendar, just in case, with the date subject to changes based on Covid rules for gatherings

### **50th Anniversary Event**

- We're not sure we can get the October 3rd date due to another event booked at the site but it may become available still
- There was a motion to hold the event June 2021 instead, and it was seconded, voted, and passed
- Baron David will petition the Kingdom to reserve the weekend for June 2021

### **SUN Event in November**

- We were awarded SUN, so Baron David, who will be running it, will now be looking into a hotel and other details
- The event is now on the calendar
- There is no dinner included but we can look into a dinner reservation at a restaurant if there is interest
- We will ask about lunch at the site student cafeteria but its run by volunteers so they may say no
- It will be held at the CMU north campus which is a historic building, very nice, with a big parking lot, and a circle drive for loading, located near Assiniboine Park
- It is a dry site
- It was suggested that this site may also be good for coronation
