Old Business

Old Business

Masks

Gimli 2020

-It was decided that we should postpone Gimli because the regulations/restrictions will be too challenging to work around

-There was a suggestion of a local gathering with games instead

-People will need to bring their own food and follow local gathering rules

-One suggested activity was youth and adult rat decorating competitions with winner by votes, other ideas were also discussed

-It was asked if “Plague Gimli” should be held on the usual Gimli weekend or another date – it was decided that a poll will be put on the Facebook group for the best date, and that a back-up date will also be selected in case of bad weather

Shilo Demo

-The local Shilo newspaper, The Shilo Stag, has approached us regarding writing a piece on the SCA

-It was suggested that after Covid restrictions lift we could hold a demo at Shilo to help get a nice front page article for the newspaper; it would be next spring probably

- Associate:** \$30.00 – Membership only. Publications and electronic newsletters are not available for this membership type.
- Family:** One additional adult and any minor children 21 and under residing at the same address as an International Member. Family members are extended the privileges of Associate Membership. A maximum of \$86 will be collected from families with one International and three or more family members (\$56 + \$30).

NOTE: A separate application form must be completed and signed for each family member.
